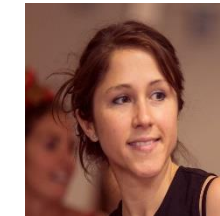
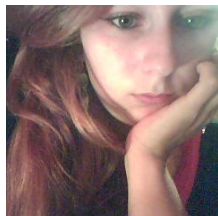
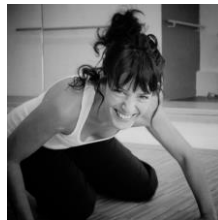

## Tips and infos

1. **Check-in:** Regular check-in will take place Friday night, at the Salle du Faubourg, from 20h00 to 00h30. If you cannot make it, you'll be able to check-in right before your first class, at the class venue. In this case, we will ask you to come at the very least 20' before the class begins.
2. **Free tickets from the airport:** If you're are coming by plane, grab a free public transport ticket *before leaving the luggage reclaim area* in the airport! You'll find the machines which distribute them next to the exit doors.
3. **Groups solo jazz** (for Full Pass holders only):
  - a. If your lindy hop level is beginner-intermediate, intermediate or intermediate-advanced, you are in the SOLO 1 group for solo jazz.
  - b. If your lindy hop level is advanced A or advanced B, you are in the SOLO 2 group for solo jazz.
4. **Places to hang out:** If you have some time to kill (or just use) do not hesitate to go to:

  - b. [La Pointe de la Jonction](#)
5. **Transport in Geneva:** You can find the schedule for tramways and buses here: <http://www.tpg.ch/en/web/site-international>. Thanks to its modest size, Geneva is an easy-to-walk city. Yet, if you have been hopping and shaking around so much that your legs won't carry you anymore you can always buy a three stops ticket ("saut de puce") or a one-hour ticket for UNIRESO.  
  
NB: UNIRESO is the united network of Geneva public transport (TPG), Federal Railways (CFF) and Boat transport (SBB) and thus you can use the same ticket for bus, train, tramway or boat.
6. **Public boats:** Think that there are boats crossing the lake ([les Mouettes](#)) that belong to Geneva public transport network.
7. **Grab a bite:** If you want to bite something near the class or party venues, you may want to pay a visit to [Le Gavroche](#). It is a nice, not too expensive, very welcoming bar/restaurant. And it's 50 meters away from the salle du Faubourg, the festival's main venue.

## Saturday and Friday Night Parties

### Salle du Faubourg

Rue des Terreaux-du-Temple 8, 1201 Geneva. Access by public transport: Bus 2, 3, 5, 7, 10, 19, Tramway 12, 14, 18 – stop “Bel-Air”; Bus 1, Tramway 15 – stop “Goulart”.

## Sunday’s Goodbye Dances

### Place Simon-Goulart

Sunday’s goodbye dances will be held in Place Simon-Goulart. Access by public transport: Bus 2, 3, 5, 7, 10, 19, Tramway 12, 14, 18 – stop “Bel-Air”; Bus 1, Tramway 15 – stop “Goulart”.

## Class venues

### Salles du Tir (*Tir 1* and *Tir 2*)

Rue du Tir 5, 1204 Geneva. There are two rooms at this address (*Tir 1* and *Tir 2*). Access by public transport: Bus 1, Tramway 14, 15 – stop “Stand”; Tramway 14 – stop “Palladium”.

### Salle du Môle

Rue du Môle 21, 1201 Genève, Suisse. This is where the solo classes take place. Access by public transport: Tramway 15 – stop “Môle”; Bus 1, 25 – stop “Navigation”.
